In an effort to bolster access to cancer screening among underserved and uninsured Texans, the Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas (CPRIT) recently awarded a \$1 million prevention grant to Rakhshanda Rahman, M.D., Rebeccah Baucom, M.D., and John Kidwell, M.D., from the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Medicine. The grant will allow the TTUHSC team to provide no-cost cancer screening and colonoscopies to underinsured and uninsured people living in 15 counties from the state's South Plains region.


