UTD Neuroscience Researcher Receives \$11.3M to Launch National Center for Cellular & Molecular Studies





Dr. Ted Price, Ashbel Smith Professor of neuroscience in the School of Behavioral and Brain Sciences, received a \$11.3 million grant from the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke to launch the Human Nociceptor and Spinal Cord Molecular Signature Center.

Researchers will focus on expanding knowledge about the genesis of human pain at the cellular and molecular level, with the goal of finding new approaches to treat pain.
