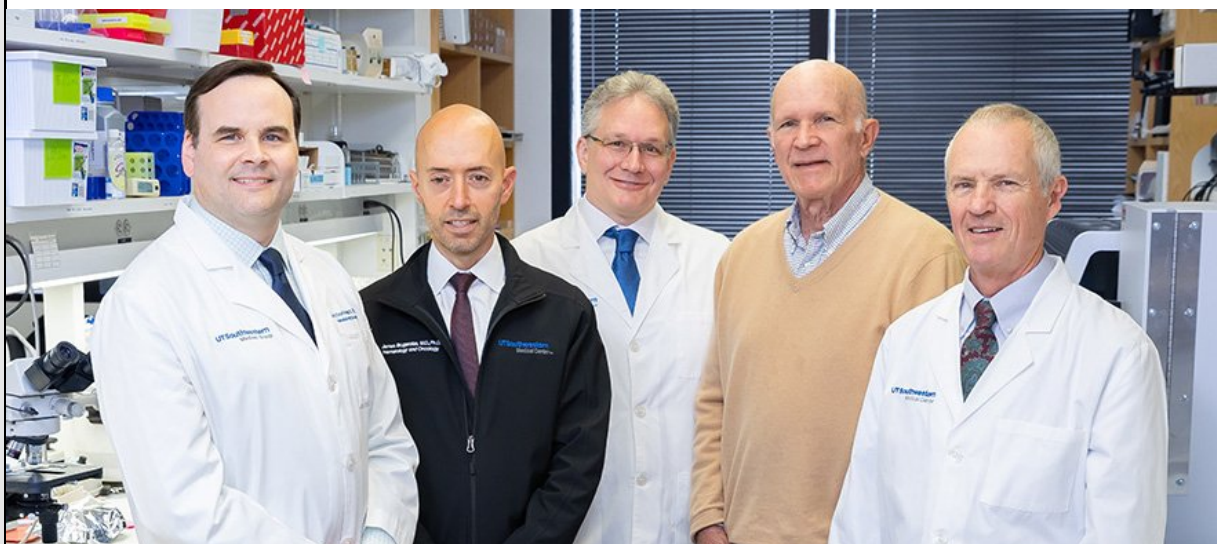
ReCode Therapeutics Starts New Phase 1 Trial Expanding More Treatments for Rare Disease



ReCode Therapeutics, a clinical-stage genetic medicines company using precision delivery to power the next wave of mRNA and gene correction therapeutics, has treated the first patient with RCT1100, an mRNA-based therapy in a Phase 1 study for primary ciliary dyskinesia (PCD) caused by DNAI1 gene mutations. PCD is a rare genetic disease affecting cilia function in the respiratory tract, leading to chronic infections.

UT Southwestern's groundbreaking kidney cancer drug, belzutifan, achieves another milestone as the U.S. Food & Drug Administration expands its approved use to include the treatment of metastatic kidney cancer.

Drs. Bruick and Gardner led the groundbreaking phase, conducting a meticulous drug screen of UT Southwestern's chemical library to pinpoint compounds capable of inhibiting HIF-2 α function.

Driving Growth: Texans Approve Tax-Exemption for Bio-Medical Equipment Manufacturers

Proposition 10, titled the "Tax Exemption on Medical and Bio-Medical Equipment and Inventory Amendment," was approved by voters in November 2023!

The approval of Proposition 10 signifies a collective endorsement from the Texas electorate to provide tax relief to medical and biopharma manufacturers. This constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation, equipment or inventory, held by a manufacturer of medical or biomedical products to protect the Texas healthcare network and strengthen our industry's supply chain.

This legislation stimulates the medical and biopharma manufacturing sector by alleviating the tax burden associated with the production and inventory of biomedical equipment.
