UTA Researcher Earns \$250,000 CPRIT Grant to Explore How T-Cells Detect Cancer



The University of Texas at Arlington's bioengineering professor, Dr. George Alexandrakis received a \$250,000 CPRIT grant. He is leading a state-funded project that will try to identify what

T-cells are detecting in cancerous cells to better understand personalized cancer immunotherapy.

"One of the challenges with cancer is that it is so variable. It changes all the time and is different in all people," Alexandrakis said. Dr, Alexandrakis's CPRIT-funded research will contribute to ongoing efforts focused on unmasking cancer cells and making them visible to a patient's immune system.
