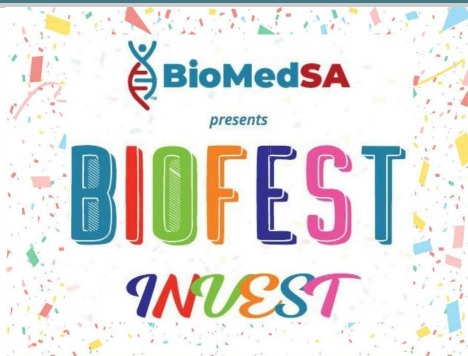
Dallas College and UT Southwestern have worked together to create and support the joint virtual care program, said Beth Stall, Director of Academic Services at Dallas College.
