Boot Camp for Biotech Coming Soon!



Through an \$8.8 million grant awarded to Dallas College by the U.S. Economic Development Administration, University of Texas at Arlington is playing a key role in training the future of the biotech industry in North Texas. Work with Collin College, Dallas College and Tarrant County College UTA will create a new regional career training pathway in biotechnology, biomanufacturing and bioinformatics.

The partnership will create BioWorks for North Texas, an introductory "boot camp" to train 800 participants from historically underserved North Texas communities for entry-level biotech employment. UTA will recruit and train 100 of those participants while working with employers to develop biotech training and education programs.

New NSF Grant To Advance Quantum Research, Education at UT Dallas



The coldest place in North Texas — a physics lab at The University of Texas at Dallas — is about to heat up, thanks to a five-year, \$5 million grant from the National Science Foundation (NSF) to advance the science and engineering — and train the workforce — needed to make neutral-atom-based quantum information processing a reality.

In addition to basic research aimed at transitioning reliable quantum information technologies from theory to practice, the grant supports the development of a new undergraduate minor and a master's degree in quantum information science and engineering (QISE), which would be the first such graduate degree offered in Texas.
